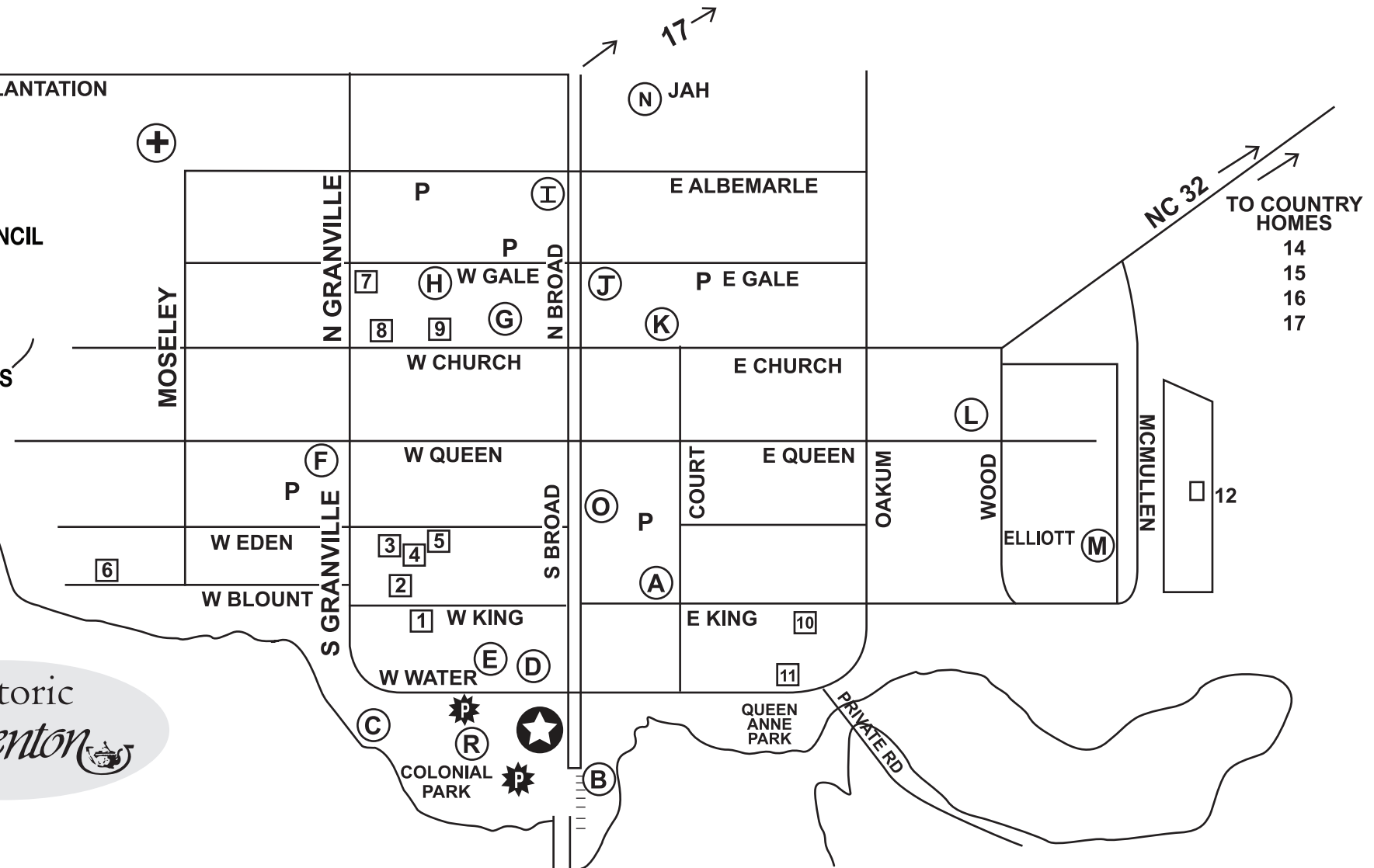

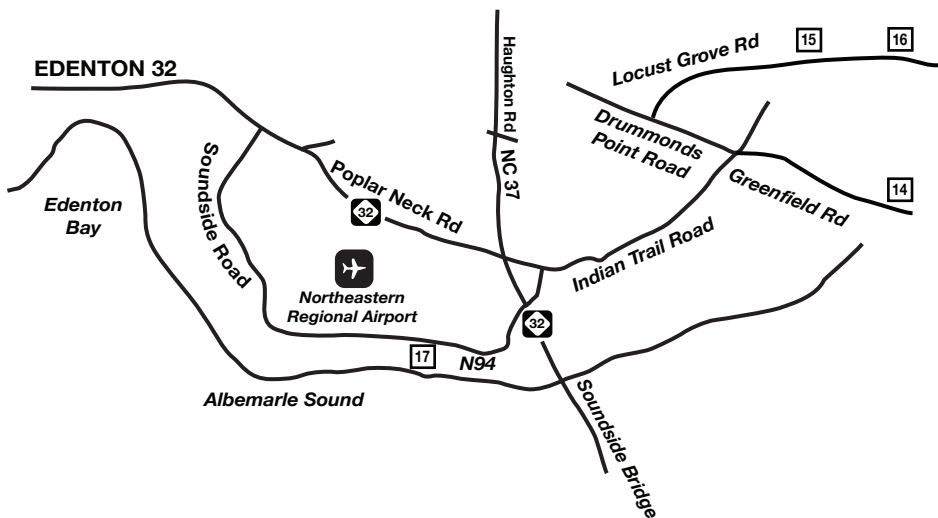

Directions to Countryside Houses

* Shelton Plantation(# 13 on map) From Barker House drive on Broad St., .9 mile turn left on 32N at stop light, drive 1.6 miles, turn left onto gravel drive, note #667 on mailbox and flag marking driveway.

* To Greenfield #14 , Long Beach #15, Mount Auburn #16, and Mulberry Hill #17 on map: From Barker House drive on Broad St. Turn right on 32 S (East Church St.) NC 32 becomes Poplar Neck Rd. drive 4.5 miles, stop at blinking light and cross HWY 37. This is now Indian Trail Rd. Drive 4.2 miles turn right on Drummond's Point Rd. Go .5 miles bear right onto Greenfield Rd. The house, Greenfield #14, will be .9 miles on the left.

Drive back to Drummond's Point Rd. Drive .3 miles, turn right onto Locust Grove Rd. (gravel road). Drive 1.7 miles, turn left into drive #2333, follow flag and signs to Long Beach #15.

* Return to Locust Grove Rd. Turn left, drive approximately .2 miles. Turn left at #2352, follow flag and signs to Mount Auburn #16.

Leaving Mount Auburn, return to Indian Trail Rd. back to blinking light, turn left onto NC 32/37, go .5 miles turn right on 94/Soundside Road. Go 1.0 mile, turn left on Mulberry Hill Lane, go .2 miles to Mulberry Hill #17, entrance at white fence, follow flag and signs.

Back to Edenton: exit from Mulberry Hill Lane turn left on Soundside Dr. Drive 5 miles to stop sign turn left on NC 32 drive 1.9 miles, returning to East Church St. and Broad St..
